NEW TEXT SERVICE to UPDATE YOUR MEDICAL RECORDS

The Surgery are using a new text service in order to update your medical records, which may have become out-of-date over time. Over the coming months the Medical Centre will be messaging patients asking for height and weight, smoking status, blood pressure and other details as you would have provided when you first registered with the Practice. Because the system may not be able to cope with all the questions at once they will try to spread these messages out so you don't feel bombarded. After the initial message, 2 reminder messages will be sent on days 3 and 6 to those patients who have yet to respond. For blood pressure readings, you are welcome to use the BP machine in our waiting room.

If you receive a text message from "Witterings" including a link which begins with "floreys.accurx" asking for your height & weight, smoking status or blood pressure, please be assured the message is legitimate and it is quite safe to respond.

The messages will include a link to enable you to reply. Your details will then be automatically saved to your medical records. If you have any problems with the link, you can email your results to reception.witterings@nhs.net

Please do not telephone the Surgery with your results



as this prevents reception staff taking other more urgent calls.

FREE Safe and Well Visit

This information is provided as a result of the Medical Centre reporting there have been some very unfortunate incidents which were caused due to lack of awareness or knowledge of fire hazards and use of flammable products.

A Safe and Well Visit is a free service carried out by West Sussex Fire & Rescue Service. It involves a pre-arranged visit to your home to offer advice on how to make it safer and, where appropriate, fit smoke alarms or other specialist fire detection equipment free of charge.

They offer visits to individuals and groups within our communities most in need – e.g. those over 65, lone adults with children, those who have a disability etc. Visits normally last between 30-45 minutes. The fire service personnel who visit always carry identification. Part of the advice they can give is around smoking, e-cigarette safety and use of flammable products.
